Upon being entered each band will receive passes for each of their registered competing members and their Drum Major as shown on a list submitted with the entry. **If a lesser number of players actually appears on the field for the massed bands, they must return extra passes or have \$20 per person short deducted from their travel money.**

Drawing will take place at the Registration Building at 10 AM as well as final instructions. A band representative must be present at this meeting.
